Examples would include but are not limited to educators, volunteers, administrators, or others who have effected change at the school or district level, individuals working with after-school or summer programs, or persons who have made significant contributions to science initiatives in a city, area, or state. We welcome individuals working in charter, private, and public schools, as well as organizations such as museums, after school clubs, and other organizations dedicated to student education and success. *(The Academy also offers awards for those who have demonstrated excellence in science education directly with their own students – Outstanding Science Teacher Awards).*
